963 scientific units divided into four categories: A+, A, B, C






Monographs

(chapters, editied volumes)

Conditions

- I. It has to be reviewed and present an original research problem.
- 2. It has to contain a bibliography.
- 3. Its length should be at least 6 author's sheets.
- 4. Chapter lenght should be at least a half of author's sheet.

3. Some Consequences



Writing in Polish

Monographs and chapters bring more points, when they are written in a **congress language*** than in **Polish**: it does not depend on the publisher's rank or the place of publication.

^{*} English, German, French, Spanish, Russian, and Italian

Unintended Uses

Some universities have published such regulations:

- ▶ If you want to get a Ph.D., you have to collect 80 points (of course apart from writing the thesis), and
- ▶ If you want to get a habilitation*, you have to collect 250 points.

* the highest academic qualification in Poland
